### County of Simcoe



County of Simcoe Population: 533,170 (Includes Barrie & Orillia)

65 years + 19.9% Simcoe County

**18.5% Ontario** 

**19.0% Canada** 

31% of Simcoe County's population is 55+ (41% by 2041)

- Wait lists for Senior's Housing
  - 40% seniors on social housing wait list. (5 year wait time)
  - Long-Term Care 149 days
  - Supportive Housing 9 years
- Paramedic Services
  - 48% of all calls 65+





### Community Paramedicine



#### 911 Referrals

- Paramedics assess & identify patients with unmet health and social needs
- All referrals are reviewed and submitted to partner organizations including 211, Home and Community Care, CMHA and our CP Home Visit Program
- Approximately 100 referrals per month (65% services initiated)
