



Labour Force Entrants vs Retirees


In 1996 in Huron County, for example, there were approximately 170 potential labour market entrants for every 100 retirees.

If we only factor in births and deaths the blue areas will grow and the grey areas will decline.



This Means: 94.5% of all immigrants went to the top 10 destinations leaving just 5.5% for all of the rest of Ontario


